Instruction to candidates for the Joint Entrance Examination - 2010 (EVETS 2010) for Admission to **Bachelor Course of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry (B.V.Sc. & A.H.)** in West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences for the academic session 2010-11.

The Board will conduct the Entrance Examination called EVETS-2010 as per following programme :

Applicants seeking admission to the aforesaid course will have to appear in all the above subjects.

EXAMINATION AND QUESTION PATTERN :

A written test will be conducted by "West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board." There will be two Papers. Paper - I : **Biological Sciences** - 100 marks; Paper -II : **Physics & Chemistry** - 100 marks. All the questions will be of MCQ type and to be answered in **OMR Answer Sheet** in black / blue ball pen. The questions will be set in English language **with Bengali translation. For every wrong answer 1/3 mark of that question will be deducted.**

NO. OF SEATS : 60

Reservations : SC - 22%, ST- 6% and Physically* Challenged (Handicapped) - 3%.

As the reservation for Physically Challenged (Handicapped) candidates is on horizontal basis, the selected candidates will be placed in the appropriate category i.e., General, SC and ST to which candidates belong.

ELIGIBILITY :

Candidate must be a Citizen of India.

Age : Candidate must have attained 17 years of age as on **1st July, 2010**. There is no upper age limit.

Educational Qualification :

General Candidates must have passed H.S. (10+2) Examination of West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination recognized by the West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences with individual pass marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, English and Vernacular (or any other fifth subject) along with a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in the said qualifying examination (10+2). In respect of SC and ST candidates the aforesaid percentage of marks will be 40% instead of 50%. Candidates appearing in (10+2) examination in 2010 and subsequently fulfilling the above criteria are also eligible to appear in EVETS-2010.

N.B.:

Only Mathematics or Statistics or Mechanics will be considered as additional subjects in H.S.(10+2) level (W.B.C.H.S.E.) in General Stream.

RESIDENTIAL CRITERIA:

Candidates must have been residing in the State of West Bengal for a minimum period of 10 (ten) years uninterruptedly as on 31.12.2009 or their parents must be permanent resident of West Bengal having their permanent home address in the State of West Bengal.

Residential certificate in this regard shall have to be produced in the proforma as printed in the Application Form for EVETS-2010 from any of the competent Authorities as mentioned below. No separate supporting documents or residential certificate in any other form will be accepted along with the filled in application form.

Competent Authorities for issue of Residential Certificate for EVETS-2010:

The Residential Certificate either in the form A or B as applicable should be obtained from any of the following competent authorities, [viz., (i) District Magistrate, (ii) Additional District Magistrate, (iii) Deputy Magistrate, (iv) Deputy Collector, (v) Sub-Divisional Officer, (vi) Block Development Officer, (vii) Superintendent of Police or Additional Supdt. of Police, (viii) Chief or Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, (ix) Director of Scheduled Caste and Tribe Welfare, (x) Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner of Kolkata Police, (xi) Deputy Secretary or above to the government of West Bengal, (xii) Heads of the Institutions (located in West Bengal) where the applicants are presently studying or last studied, (xiii) Members of Parliament in West Bengal, (xiv) Members of West

Bengal Legislative Assembly, (xv) Sabhapati-Panchayet Samity (xvi) Mayor-
in-Council, Municipal Corporation (xvii) Municipal Commissioner and
(xviii) Chairman Borough Committee] in whose jurisdiction the candidates reside.

APPLICATION:

Candidates intending to appear in the Joint Entrance Examination-2010 (EVETS-2010), shall have to apply in the prescribed Application Form which along with the Information Sheet will be available w.e.f.

01-03-2010

to 31-03-2010 from the Branch Offices of **UNITED BANK OF INDIA** at **Jadavpur, Sealdah, , BESUS - Howrah, Serampore, Bankura, Bardhaman, Durgapur City Centre, Medinipur, Tamluk, Krishnanagar, Berhampore, Malda, Coochbehar, Siliguri, Suri, Barasat, Purulia, Raigunge, Jalpaiguri** on all working days on payment of Rs. 350/- in **CASH**.

There is also a provision for obtaining Application Form along with Information brochure from the Office of the BOARD through Postal request only on or before 19-03-2010 by sending a Bank Draft of Rs. 450/- (application form Rs 350+ Postal & Other charges Rs 100/- total to be Rs 450/-) to be drawn in favour of '**WEST BENGAL JOINT ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS BOARD**' payable at Kolkata / Howrah. Completed application should reach the office of the Board on or before **10.04.2010**. The Application form once sold cannot be returned or replaced.

SUBMISSION :

The duly filled in Application Forms must be sent by **Speed Post** only so as to reach the Office of the Board on or before 10.04.2010. Submission of Application Form by hand / courier service will not be accepted. It should be noted that tampering of the form or photograph would automatically lead to cancellation of the candidature.

ISSUE OF ADMIT CARD AND ENROLMENT:

After receipt of Application Form by the Board, an Admit Card will be sent to the eligible applicant indicating his/her Examination Centre of the Entrance Examination. **The Form Number will serve as the Enrolment Number.**

In case the applicant does not receive the Admit Card by **May 8, 2010**, he/she should contact this Board website to ascertain as to whether his/ her Application Form Number is included within the cancellation list of application forms. If not, then he/she should contact personally/through authorized representative along with following relevant documents for procurement of duplicate admit card from Board's Office.

- a) Xerox copy of the filled-in Application Form.

- b) Postal slip (Speed Post) for despatch of filled-in Application Form.
- c) Two identical copies of the colour photographs (as pasted in the Application Form) duly attested by the Head of the recognised institution last attended.
- d) Original admit cards of Madhyamik(10th Standard) or equivalent examinations/H. S. (10+2) or equivalent examinations.
- e) Duplicate admit cards will be issued from the office of the Board, to the concerned candidates in person from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. during the period from 10.05.2010 to 13.05.2010.

After receipt, if the Original admit card is lost **before examination** then for obtaining the duplicate admit card the original copy of the missing diary lodged in the local police station in this regard will have to be produced in addition to the aforesaid documents; as stated above [Vide a) to d)]. Requisite fee of Rs.200/-(Rupees Two hundred only) in the form of a Bank Draft to be drawn in favour of "West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board," payable at Kolkata / Howrah has to be paid for the purpose. Candidates must ensure that the photographs on the admit card are not mutilated/distorted/soiled even by accident. **Candidates with such admit cards will not be allowed to appear in the Entrance Examination.**

Candidates must retain their admit cards carefully in a secured place in undamaged condition in all respect till the completion of admission procedure.

No duplicate Admit Card will be issued after the end of the Entrance Examination under any circumstances.

ZONE OF EXAMINATION:

The Examination will be held simultaneously at the following places provided there are sufficient candidates in the Zone. If sufficient applicants are not available for a particular zone, another zone will be allotted to them.

The allotment of zone and examination centre is fully at the discretion of the Board. Any allotment made by the Board is final and no request for changing the zone / centre of examination will be entertained under any circumstances.

EVALUATION AND DECLARATION OF RESULTS OF EVETS - 2010 :

Rules for scrutiny/review of Answer Sheet : The Board neither publishes nor communicates the result to any individual applicant. It does not have any provision for post publication scrutiny and /or review and hence will not entertain any such application after the examination.

Result : Results of 'EVETS' - 2010' are likely to be declared in the month of June, 2010. Results will be available in Board's website (www.wbjeeb.in) The Board will publish the merit list(s). The number of merit listed candidates will be decided by the appropriate authority.

LEGAL JURISDICTION:

All disputes pertaining to conduct of EVETS - 2010 shall fall within the jurisdiction of Kolkata only. The Board will not be a party pertaining to any dispute arising in the process of admission to any course of study through EVETS - 2010.

ADMISSION :

It should be noted that the Board is in no way responsible for admission to the Institutions and the candidates have to comply with the requirements of eligibility conditions for admission to West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences. The Board only provides the merit list of the Entrance Examination to the authority of West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences, 68 & 37, Kshudiram Bose Sarani, Kolkata - 700 037 (Ph. No. 033 2558-0278).

All applicants who appear to be prima-facie eligible are provisionally permitted to sit for the Entrance Examination. If after scrutiny at any stage, it is found that an applicant is otherwise ineligible, his / her candidature will automatically be cancelled even if he / she has appeared at the examination and secured a position in the Merit List.

A candidate shall be required to produce mark sheets in original of all the examinations passed together with the admit card of Madhyamik or equivalent examination as the proof of his / her age for verification at the time of admission.

Counselling for admission : After publication of Merit list, the successful candidates must take detailed information from the West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences, 68 & 37, Kshudiram Bose Sarani, Kolkata - 700 037 (Ph. No. 033 2558-0278 and website - www.wbuafscl.ac.in) for counselling and Admission to **Bachelor Course of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry (B.V.Sc. & A.H.)**. The said application form for counselling will be available from the office of the the West Bengal University of Animal and Fishery Sciences, 68 & 37, Kshudiram Bose Sarani, Kolkata -700 037

(Ph. No. 033 2558-0278) the information will be circulated broadly in due course of time by the competent authority.

The SC/ST candidates must submit original caste certificate at the time of counselling for admission.

MEDICAL FITNESS :

The candidates finally selected for admission to the aforesaid course will be required to undergo medical check-up within the specified date and the said admission will be subject to medical fitness.

Only medically fit candidates declared by the University Medical Officer or Medical Board constituted for the purpose would be considered for admission.

CERTIFICATE FOR SC/ST :

Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe candidates in W.B., as specified in Govt. of W.B. Order No. 111(2)-TW/EC dated 07.03.91/ order no. 905- TW/EC/SC/O/MR-1/95(l) dated 12.09.1995 are eligible for admission through Entrance Examination, 2010. The Original Caste certificates will have to be produced at the time of counselling from the competent authorities viz., i) District Magistrate, ii) Collector, iii) Addl. District Magistrate, iv) Dy. Collector, v) Sub-Div. Officer, vi) Sub-Div. Magistrate, vii) Executive Magistrate, viii) 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate, ix) Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Kolkata, x) Addl. Chief Metro. Magistrate, Kolkata, xi) Metropolitan Magistrate, Kolkata and xii) Collector of Land Revenue, xiii) Deputy Collector of Land Revenue, within their respective jurisdictions. However, Director/ Deputy Director, Scheduled Caste and Tribes Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal can issue such certificate in case of candidates claiming to be Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe residing in any part of West Bengal.
