Instructions to candidates for the Joint Entrance Examination - 2010 (JENPARH-2010) for Admission to **B.A.M.S. (Ayurvedacharyya)**, **B.H.M.S. (Homoeopathy)**, **B.Sc. (Hons) Nursing, BPT (Physiotherapy)** and **B.U.M.S.** (Bachelor of Unani Medicine & Surgery) courses in different Government/Private Ayurvedic Medical Colleges, Homoeopathic Medical Colleges, Nursing Colleges / Institutes, Physiotherapy Colleges / Institutes and Unani College of the State of West Bengal during the academic session 2010-2011.

The Board will conduct the Admission Test called JENPARH-2010 as per following programme :

Applicants seeking admission to any of the aforesaid courses will have to appear in all the above subjects.

EXAMINATION AND QUESTION PATTERN

A written test will be conducted by “West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board.” There will be two Papers. Paper - I : **Biological Sciences** - 100 marks ; Paper - II : **Physics & Chemistry** - 100 marks. All the questions will be of MCQ type and to be answered in **OMR Answer Sheet**. The questions will be in English language **with Bengali translation. For every wrong answer 1/3 (one third) mark of that question will be deducted.**

ELIGIBILITY :

Applicant must be a Citizen of India.

Age : Not less than 17 years as on 31st December, 2010 for all courses.

(a) BAMS, BHMS, BPT (Physiotherapy) and BUMS : The applicant having passed / appeared / due to appear in the year 2010 at the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) recognised by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Examination with the subjects English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology and also Vernacular or any other 5th subject.

(b) B.Sc. (H) Nursing: Only female candidates having passed / appeared / due to appear in the year 2010 at the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) or equivalent examination recognized by West Bengal University of Health Sciences with 50% marks (40% for SC/ST) in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Biology and English taken together and having passed in each subject individually are eligible.

RESIDENTIAL CRITERIA :

(a) BAMS, BHMS, BPT (Physiotherapy) and BUMS : Candidates must have been residing in the State of West Bengal Uninterruptedly for a minimum period of 10 (ten) years as on 31.12.2009 or their parents must be permanent residents of West Bengal having their permanent home addresses in the State of West Bengal.

(b) Nursing (H) : For admission to government colleges, the candidates either must have been residing in the State of West Bengal uninterruptedly for not less than 10 years as on 31.12.2009 or their parents must be permanent residents of West Bengal having their permanent home addresses in the State of West Bengal. However, candidates of the States other than West Bengal may be considered for admission to non-government Nursing Colleges / Institutions.

Competent Authority to issue Residential Certificate for JENPARH-2010 :

Residential certificate shall have to be produced in the proforma as printed in the Application Form for JENPARH-2010. (No separate supporting documents or residential certificate in any form will be accepted).

The Residential Certificate either A or B as applicable should be obtained from any of the following competent authorities, [viz., i) District Magistrate, ii) Additional District Magistrate, iii) Deputy Magistrate, iv) Deputy Collector, v) Sub-Divisional Officer, vi) Block Development Officer, vii) Superintendent of Police or Additional Supdt. of Police, viii) Chief or Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, ix) Director of Scheduled Caste and Tribe Welfare, x) Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner of Kolkata Police, xi) Deputy Secretary or above to the government of West Bengal, xii) Heads of the Institutions (located in West Bengal) where the applicants are presently studying or last studied, xiii) Members of Parliament in West Bengal, xiv) Members of West Bengal Legislative Assembly, xv) Sabhapati - Panchayet Samity, xvi) Mayor-in-Council, Municipal Corporation, xvii) Municipal Commissioner and Chairman, Borough Committee] in whose jurisdiction the candidates reside.

RESERVATION :

Reservation of seats for SC/ST etc. candidates will be as per govt. rules.

APPLICATION :

Candidates intending to appear in the Joint Entrance Examination-2010 (JENPARH-2010), shall have to apply in the prescribed Application Forms which along with Information Brochure will be available w.e.f. **01.03.2010 to 31.03.2010** from the Branch Offices of **UNITED BANK OF INDIA** at **Jadavpur, Sealdah, Old Court House Street, BESUS - Howrah, Serampore, Bankura, Barasat, Bardhaman, Durgapur City Centre, Medinipur, Tamluk, Krishnanagar, Berhampore, Malda, Coochbehar, Siliguri, Suri, Purulia, Raigunge, Jalpaiguri** on all working days on payment of Rs. 350/- in **CASH**. The Application Forms and the Information Brochures may also be obtained from-**Govt. and Govt. aided Homoeopathic, Ayurvedic and Physiotherapy Colleges** during the above said

period on deposit of a **Bank Draft/Pay Order of Rs. 350/-** to be drawn in favour of **WEST BENGAL JOINT ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS BOARD'** payable at Kolkata [for details visit website - www.wbjeeb.in]

There is also a provision for obtaining Application Form along with Information Brochure from the Office of the BOARD through Postal request only on or before 19.03.2010 by sending a Bank Draft of Rs. 450/- drawn in favour of '**WEST BENGAL JOINT ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS BOARD'** payable at Kolkata. **The Application form once sold cannot be returned or replaced.**

Application forms may also be obtained from the Board's office by hand on payment of late fee of Rs. 50/- only in addition to the actual cost of the form. Total amount is therefore Rs. 400/- is to be paid through Bank Draft/Pay Order to be drawn in favour "**West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board**" payable at Kolkata/Howrah from 05.04.2010 to 09.04.2010.

(B) Candidates may also send the duly filled-in application forms through **SPEED POST** only so as to reach the Office of the Board on or before 10.04.2010. No application will be received by hand at the office of the Board. The scheduled caste/ Scheduled tribe candidates must submit original caste certificate at the time of counselling for admission.

ISSUE OF ADMIT CARD AND ENROLMENT :

After receipt of Application Form by the Board, Admit Card will be sent to the applicant indicating his/her Examination Centre of the Joint Entrance Examination. **The Form Number will serve as the Enrolment Number.**

In case the applicant does not receive the Admit Card by **30.04.2010**, he/she should contact this Board website to ascertain as to whether his/her Application Form Number is included within the cancellation list of application forms. If not, then he/she should contact personally/through authorized representative along with following relevant documents for procurement of duplicate admit card from the Board's office.

- a) Xerox copy of the filled-in Application Form.
- b) Postal slip(Speed Post) for despatch of filled-in Application Form/ Acknowledgement Slip for submission of Form by hand.
- c) Two identical copies of the colour photographs (as pasted in the Application Form) duly attested by the Head of the recognised institution last attended.
- d) *Original admit cards of Madhyamik(10th Standard) or equivalent examinations/ H.S.(10+2) or equivalent examinations.*

Duplicate admit card will be issued from the office of the Board, to the concerned candidates in person from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. during the period from 03.05.2010 to 06.05.2010.

After receipt, if the Original admit card is lost before examination then for obtaining the duplicate admit card, the original copy of the missing diary lodged in the local police station in this regard will have to be produced in addition to the aforesaid

documents; as stated above [(Vide a) to d)]. Requisite fee of Rs.200/- (Rupees Two hundred only) in the form of a Bank Draft / Pay Order to be drawn in favour of "West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board," payable at Kolkata/Howrah has to be paid for the purpose.

Candidates must ensure that the photographs on the admit card are not mutilated/ distorted/soiled even by accident. **Candidates with such admit cards will not be allowed to appear in the Joint Entrance Examination.**

Candidates must retain their admit cards carefully in a secured place in undamaged condition in all respect till the completion of admission procedure.

No duplicate Admit Card will be issued after the end Joint Entrance Examination under any circumstances.

All applicants who appear to be prima facie eligible are provisionally permitted to sit for the Joint Entrance Examination. If, after scrutiny at any stage. it is found that an applicant is otherwise ineligible his/her candidature will be automatically cancelled even if he/she has appeared at the Examination and secured a position in the merit list or at any stage during Counselling/admission or registration.

The candidature of a candidate will be automatically cancelled if he/she fails to produce any of the required appropriate documents in original during admission / registration for fulfillment of eligibility and other criteria.

ZONE OF EXAMINATION :

The Examination will be held simultaneously at the following places provided there are sufficient candidates in the Zone. If sufficient applicants are not available for a particular zone, nearer zone will be allotted to them.

The allotment of zone and examination centre is fully at the discretion of the Board. Any allotment made by the Board is final and no request for changing the zone / centre of examination will be entertained under any circumstances.

EVALUATION AND DECLARATION OF RESULTS OF JENPARH – 2010 :

Rules for scrutiny/review of Answer Sheet : The Board neither publishes nor communicates the result to any individual applicant. It does not have any provision for post publication scrutiny and or review and hence will not entertain any such application after the examination.

Result : Results of 'JENPARH - 2010' are likely to be declared in the month of June, 2010. Results will be available in Board's website (www.wbjeeb.in) The Board will publish the merit list(s). The number of merit listed candidates will be decided by the appropriate authority.

LEGAL JURISDICTION :

All disputes pertaining to conduct of JENPARH - 2010 shall fall within the jurisdiction of Kolkata only.

The Board will not be a party pertaining to any dispute arising in the process of admission to any course of study through JENPARH - 2010.

ADMISSION :

It should be noted that the Board is no way be responsible for admission to the respective Institutions and the candidates have to comply with the requirement of eligibility conditions for admission to respective Institutions. The Board only provides the merit list of the Entrance Examination to the (i) **Central Selection Committee (ISM&H)**, [Swasthya Bhawan, G.N. 29, Sector - V, Salt Lake City, Kolkata - 700091 constituted by Deptt. of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal for admission to B.A.M.S. (Ayurvedacharyya), B.H.M.S. (Homoeopathy), BPT (Physiotherapy) and BUMS (Unani) courses (ii) **Central Selection Committee (Nursing)**, [W.B. Govt. College of Nursing, Kolkata, SSKM Hospital Campus, 244, A.J.C.Bose Road, Kolkata-700 020] for admission to B.Sc. (Hons) Nursing course.

The SC/ST candidates must submit original caste certificate at the time of counselling for admission.

MEDICAL FITNESS :

The candidates finally selected for admission to the respective courses will be required to undergo medical check-up within the specified date and the said admission will be subject to medical fitness.

Certificate for SC/ST : Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe candidates in W.B., as specified in Govt. of W. B. Order No. 111(2)-TW/EC dated 07.03.91/ order no. 905-TW/EC/SC/O/MR-1/95(1) dated 12.09.1995 are eligible for admission through Joint Entrance Examination, 2010 under SC/ST quota. **However, SC / ST candidates hailing from States other than West Bengal are not eligible for such benefit and they will be treated as General Category candidates.** The Caste certificates will have to be produced at the time of counselling from the competent authorities viz., i) District Magistrate, ii) Collector, Addl. District Magistrate, iii) Dy. Collector, iv) Sub-Div. Officer, v) Sub-Div. Magistrate, vi) Executive Magistrate, vii) 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate, viii) Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Kolkata, ix) Addl. Chief Metro. Magistrate, Kolkata, x) Metropolitan Magistrate, Kolkata and Collector of Land Revenue, xi) Deputy Collector of Land Revenue, within their respective jurisdictions. However, Director/ Deputy Director, Scheduled Caste and Tribes Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal can issue such certificate in case of candidates claiming to be Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe residing in any part of West Bengal.
