NOTIFICATION

As per the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board Act, 2014, the State Govt. has conferred the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board (WBJEEB) the status of a Statutory Body. As per the provisions of this Act, the WBJEEB has to conduct centralized counseling and admission process of the merit listed candidates seeking admission to 2nd Year (3rd Semester) of Engineering/Pharmacy Degree courses in Colleges/Institutions and Universities of West Bengal through LATERAL ENTRY scheme for the academic session 2017-18.

For admission into **such courses**, it is essential for the candidates to appear in the State Common Entrance Examination i.e. JELET – 2017 and to secure a rank. It has been decided by the State Government in the Higher Education Department to continue the admission process on the basis of the norms framed by AICTE and other regulatory authorities. The guidelines and instructions for centralized counseling and admission in the **2nd Year (3rd Semester) of Engineering/Pharmacy Degree** course for academic session 2017-18 are provided hereunder :

01. Eligibility criteria –

1.1 Citizenship: The applicant must be a **citizen of India**.

1.2 Age Restriction:

- I. There is **no upper age limit** for Diploma holders in Engineering/ Technology/ Pharmacy.
- II. For B. Sc. Candidates, the **upper age limit** is 27 (twenty seven) years as on 31.12.2017.
- iii. For Diploma holders in Marine Engineering, the **upper age limit** is 25 (twenty five) years as on 31.12.2017

1.3 Diploma holders seeking admission into Engineering & Technology Degree Course

1.3.1 The candidate must pass Diploma in Engineering/ Technology from an AICTE approved Institution with at least 45% (40% for SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ PwD) marks or equivalent CGPA.

1.3.2 All relevant norms of **D. G. Shipping** will be applicable for admission into Degree Course in Marine Engineering.

1.4 B. Sc. candidates seeking admission into Engineering & Technology Degree Course

1.4.1 The candidate must pass B. Sc. Degree from any University recognised by UGC with at least 45% (40% for SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ PwD) marks.

1.4.2 Also the candidate must have passed 12th standard school examination with Mathematics as a subject.

1.4.3 The candidate, if admitted, will have to clear the subjects of Engineering Mechanics and Engineering Graphics / Engineering Drawing of the 1st year Degree Course in Engineering/Technology along with their second year subjects.

1.4.4 B.Sc. candidates will be considered for admission only if vacancies remain even after filling up of the seats with available Diploma holder candidates.

1.4.5 B. Sc. Candidates are not eligible for admission into Degree Course in Pharmacy.

1.5 Both Diploma holder and B. Sc. Candidates seeking admission into Engineering & Technology Degree Course

Both such candidates will also be eligible for admission to the 1st year Engineering Degree Courses subject to vacancies in the 1st year classes in case the vacancies as lateral entry at second year are exhausted. However, the admission shall be based strictly on the eligibility criteria as is mentioned above.

1.6 Diploma holders in Pharmacy seeking admission into Degree Course in Pharmacy

1.6.1 The candidate must pass Diploma in Pharmacy from an AICTE approved institution with at least 45% (40% for SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ PwD) marks or equivalent CGPA.

1.6.2 Such candidates will also be eligible for admission to the 1st year Degree Course subject to vacancies in the 1st year classes in case the vacancies as lateral entry at second year are exhausted. However, the admission shall be based strictly on the eligibility criteria as is mentioned above.

1.7 Special criteria for admission in Jadavpur University through lateral entry

B. Sc. Degree holders are not eligible for admission in Jadavpur University through lateral entry. The Diploma holder candidates must have passed Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examination before their Diploma Course.

1.8 Candidates belonging to B.Sc. stream and taking admission to colleges affiliated to MAKAUT (formerly known as WBUT) shall have to pass in the subjects of Engineering Graphics, Engineering Drawing and Engineering Mechanics of the 1st year Engineering & Technology Programme along with the subjects offered in the second year of Engineering & Technology Programme. B.Sc. candidates admitted through Lateral Entry Programme to other universities i.e. other than MAKAUT, the subjects to be read along with the 2nd year courses may be prescribed similarly by the concerned university.

1.9 **Candidates belonging to B.Sc. stream shall be considered only after offering the seats for Lateral Entry to the candidates belonging to the Engg./Tech. Diploma holders if there is availability of appropriate vacancy.**

2.2 As per approved Calcutta University Regulation of B. Tech. in Jute & Fibre Course of Calcutta University, it is mentioned that for lateral entry admission to 2nd year (3rd semester) of B. Tech. in Jute Technology Course of Calcutta University, candidates with Diploma in Mechanical Engg. or Electrical Engg. or Chemical Engg. or Computer Engg. or Electronics Engg or Textile Technology or Textile (Handloom Technology) or Apparel/Fashion Technology or passed B. Sc. 2-year P.G. Diploma in Jute Technology/ Jute Technology and management or B. Sc. in Textile and Clothing Science or Bachelor of Fashion Design or B.Sc. (with Physics, Chemistry and mathematics) from any Institute/College or equivalent as recognised by the University of Calcutta and qualified through JELET-2017, will be eligible.

03 Reservation:

- 3.1 For Govt. Engineering & Technological Colleges and State aided Universities, reservation of seats for **SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B** and **PWD** candidates will be as per Govt. Rules. For Private Self-financed Universities, if any, reservation rules for **SC/ST** and **PWD** candidates of the concerned university shall be followed. **SUCH RESERVATION IS AVAILABLE ONLY TO CANDIDATES DOMICILED IN WEST BENGAL AND THE RESERVATION CERTIFICATES ARE TO BE ISSUED BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITIES IN WEST BENGAL.**
- 3.2 As the reservation for PwD (persons with disability) candidates is on horizontal basis, the selected candidates will be placed in General/SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B category to which he/she belongs. For PwD (loco motor disorder, visual impairment, speech and hearing impairment) category candidates a minimum of 40% disability is required subject to the condition that the candidate is capable of carrying out all activities related to theory and practical works as applicable to BE/B.Tech/B.Pharm courses without any special concession and exemption.
- 04.** Diploma holders in Fashion Technology Course of Govt. Polytechnic Institution, Tripura, will be considered for admission to Degree Level Apparel Production & Management Course and Textile Technology Course in Govt. College of Engg. & Textile Technology, Serampore and Berhampur under Lateral Entry Scheme. The domicile criteria for admission to Govt. Engineering & Technology Colleges shall not be applicable in such cases.
- 05** Domicile Certificate issued by competent authority as is mentioned in the Information Bulletin of JELET-2017 is required to be produced at the time of counselling, if the candidate seeks admission to Government Engineering and Technology Colleges (not applicable for the candidates vide Sl. No. 04).
- 06.** The candidates ear-marked under any slot of the counseling programme must report at least half an hour before the time stipulated for that slot. The counseling will not be stopped for any particular candidate being absent at the time of reporting.

07. A candidate must appear in person at the counseling venue for allotment of seat. However, if a candidate is unable to appear at the counseling in person owing to valid reasons under exceptional circumstances/medical ground, his/her parent/guardian may appear on his or her behalf with all original testimonials as specified under the heading- "Documents to carry" along with an authorization letter from the candidate and undertaking that he or she would not claim for any other seat than the one allotted to his or her parent/guardian through authorization. If the candidate is absent on medical ground, proper medical certificate is to be produced.
08. A candidate failing to appear before the officials at the allotment counter in order of his/her position in the merit list due to delay on his/her part may be allowed to present himself/herself before the counseling officers immediately after the formalities in the reception counter are over. The claim of such candidate to exercise option shall be limited to the vacancies available at the instant when his/her turn comes for appearing before the counseling officials. An undertaking to this effect is to be given by the candidate at the time of counseling.
09. A candidate can exercise option only to a single branch of a particular institution of his/her choice where he/she is eligible. The option will have to be exercised in writing with his/her signature at the time of counseling. **Once the allotment of a seat is done, no further change of the Institution/branch will be entertained. No refund of money will be allowed under any circumstances.**
10. Diploma holder teachers in Govt. Polytechnic Colleges, West Bengal are eligible for admission for the academic session 2017-18 under Lateral Entry Scheme provided they have qualified in JELET-2017 and procured requisite permission from respective controlling authorities well in advance before counseling.
11. Candidates will be required to take admission to the allotted institution within 5(five) days from the date of allotment on payment of requisite fees to the respective institution.

12. Besides the eligibility criteria prescribed by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board, a few Institutions prescribe some more eligibility criteria specific to those Institutes. The candidates must note those specific criteria before giving options to those Institutions.
13. Allotment given by West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board is entirely provisional and subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria and other conditions specified in the Information Bulletin of **JELET-2017** at the time of admission. (e.g.all relevant norms and guidelines of D.G. Shipping are to be adhered to for admission to Marine Engineering Degree Course. Similarly PCI norms for Pharmacy is to be followed).
14. Counselling as per the declared schedule shall continue till availability of seats. The counselling of a particular branch of Engineering/Technology will be stopped instantly as soon as all seats in that Branch of Engineering/Technology are filled up.
15. Candidates belonging to States other than West Bengal shall not be considered for admission to Govt. Engineering & Technology Colleges (not applicable for the candidates vide Sl. No. 04).
16. Any candidate appearing at the counselling with counterfeit documents/testimonials will be immediately handed over to the police.
17. Any other important information/notification related to the counselling will be communicated immediately through the Board's website.
